Here is a brief description of our NEMT service:

The van is available free of charge. The service is available on a reservation basis Monday – Friday from 8:00am to 5:00pm. Your appointment should be scheduled between the hours of 10:00am and 3:00pm to facilitate the transportation process. This is a shared ride service and operates to Twin Falls and back to the Wood River Valley.

A Ride request must be made <u>72 hours</u> before your appointment by calling the Mountain Rides office at 208-788-7433 x103 or by faxing a request to Mountain Rides at 1-866-554-1103 or person's with TDD access can call 726-8271 to schedule a ride. You can also email your completed form to: kim@mountainrides.org

Please let us know at least one day in advance if you will <u>NOT</u> be able to make your scheduled ride.

The van leaves the Mountain Rides facility at 121 Clover St in Bellevue at 8:00am.

If an assistant is required to get the individual in and out of the house or van, then the individual being picked-up must supply this assistant. The assistant or assistants will be allowed to ride with the person at no charge. Additional space for riders accompanying the individual will be on a space available basis at no charge. For individuals in wheelchairs, the Mountain Rides driver will perform the loading, securement, and unloading of the person using the ramp. Anyone riding in the van will be required to wear a seat belt.
